### SECTION I.

## GENERAL TAX ON REAL ESTATE VALUE.

ARTICLE I-I

That a tax of \$0.8790 per \$100. Value entered in the assessment roll, be set and imposed for the 2024 financial year, on any taxable immovable located in the territory of the municipality.

### SECTION II

## TARIFFS FOR WASTEWATER SERVICE

ARTICLE 2-1

That be required and imposed for the 2024 financial year to all property owners in St. Paul's River and Vieux Fort serviced by the wastewater system, the annual tariffs of \$166.22 multiplied by a factor expressed in units such as stated as follows with regards to cash category:
